

Cascade to make Lewiston-Olympia flight

Cascade Airways announced Friday it is inaugurating service from Lewiston to Olympia as well as resuming service to Boise Aug. 1.

In the company's announcement, Mark A. Nilson, director of sales and customer services for the Spokane-based commuter airline, described the route expansion

as the airline's "most aggressive scheduling effort to date."

Cascade now serves 16 cities in Washington, Oregon and Idaho, including Lewiston and Pullman-Moscow airports.

Cascade, now operating with seven 15-passenger Beechcraft 99 airliners, plans

to add an eighth aircraft for its August expansion to the capital cities of Washington and Idaho.
